#### Items in the pipeline

The residents' association committee meets monthly. Some of the items currently on the agenda are FCC and the ownership of Cois Inbhir, road safety, dog litter, neighbourhood watch, Cois Inbhir summer BBQ and a fun clean up day. Keep an eye out for updates.

#### Dog Litter

Dog litter has always been an issue; it is unsightly, unpleasant and most importantly dangerous. It contains <u>TOXOCARA</u> which are worms whose eggs can be passed into the faeces of cats and dogs. Once deposited on the ground, the eggs can survive for up to 7 years. Any child or grown up that comes in contact with the eggs risks ingesting them. The eggs can then hatch into larvae and cause TOXOCARIASIS which can affect the eyes, liver, lungs, heart, and brain.

Fingal Councy Council are anxious to stop this problem and have increased the fines for offending dog owners. We can all play our part in protecting our children from Toxocariasis by picking up dog litter and by ensuring the dog is not allowed to roam freely and foul in places where children will play.

- When you park, always ensure that you provide enough room for Emergency Vehicles to pass.
- Never park on or next to a Fire Hydrant.
- Never park where you obstruct the view of other drivers. This includes junctions and close to corners.
